## Watch out!

Please be aware that fraudsters posing as police officers are targeting older and vulnerable residents across the county. There has been a rise in telephone and courier frauds over the last few days in which a fraudster phones victims posing as a police officer. The caller asks their victim to go to their bank and withdraw money, often saying it's to help an investigation. The money is then collected by a courier and delivered straight to the hands of the fraudster.

The police will **never EVER** ask for your PIN, full password, send someone to your home to collect money, or your bank card.

**Please hang up immediately on calls like this. THIS IS A SCAM!**
