Knaphill Community Fridge

Did you know Knaphill has a Community Fridge? This very successful project is run by Holy Trinity with the aim of preventing unwanted food going into landfill. Collections are made from local food retailers and brought to Holy Trinity in Chobham Road where anyone can help themselves. It is available to all - this is not a food bank but a project to reduce our impact on the environment too. You can also donate any unwanted, in date, food (maybe you overstocked for a party or for before a holiday). The fridge itself is open Monday to Friday from 8.30am to 4.00pm (but the best choice of goods is to be found early in the day).

Jules Hopkins, who set up this project, is giving a talk about the work to the Silver Stars group on Monday 27th January at 1.30pm and Holy Trinity have extended an invitation to us through Church 4 Knaphill.
